## Week 1: The Divine Setup – God is Moving Behind the Scenes

Agenda: \*No more than 1hr, 15 min

- Music, Video, or Quiet Reflection (5-10 min before)
- Icebreaker/check-in/Kick it (5 minutes)
- Opening prayer (5 minutes)
- Scripture reading (10 minutes)
- Discussion questions (20–30 minutes)
- Prophetic insight sharing (10 minutes)
- Closing prayer and call to action (5 minutes)

Theme: Partnering with Heaven's Plan

Overview: The Gospel of Luke opens with a divine orchestration of events. God is setting the stage for His glory to be revealed, often in hidden, humble places.

### Daily Readings:

- Day 1: Luke 1:1–4 – The certainty of God's promises
- Day 2: Luke 1:5–17 – Zechariah's prayer is answered
- Day 3: Luke 1:18–25 – Don't let doubt silence your faith
- Day 4: Luke 1:26–38 – Mary's prophetic "yes" to God
- Day 5: Luke 1:39–45 – The power of divine connections (Elizabeth and Mary)
- Day 6: Luke 1:46–56 – The song of praise that shifts atmospheres
- Day 7: Reflection: Where is God orchestrating a setup for His glory in your life?

**Key Prophetic Insight:** God's promises are unfolding, even when you can't see it. Like Mary and Zechariah, your "yes" is the key that unlocks the miraculous.

**Prayer Focus:** Pray for fresh sensitivity to the Holy Spirit's leading and courage to say "yes" to God's plans.



## Week 2: Glory in the Ordinary – God Comes Close

Theme: Anointed to Fulfill Your Purpose

Overview: Jesus' ministry begins with the Holy Spirit's empowerment, showing us the necessity of Spirit-led living.

### Daily Readings:

- Day 1: Luke 3:21–22 – Jesus is baptized, and the heavens open
- Day 2: Luke 4:1–13 – Spirit-led through the wilderness
- Day 3: Luke 4:14–21 – Jesus declares His mission: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me
- Day 4: Luke 4:22–30 – Bold obedience often stirs opposition
- Day 5: Luke 4:31–37 – Jesus moves in authority over darkness
- Day 6: Luke 4:38–44 – Healing flows through His mission
- Day 7: Reflection: How is the Holy Spirit guiding you into your purpose?

**Key Prophetic Insight:** The Holy Spirit not only prepares you but empowers you to walk in your divine assignment. He equips you to confront opposition and bring healing to others.

**Prayer Focus:** Pray for a fresh baptism of the Holy Spirit to walk in boldness, authority, and clarity in your purpose.

Theme: Surrender Unlocks the Power

Overview: Jesus challenges us to live Kingdom-first lives, fully surrendered to God's will.

### Daily Readings:

- Day 1: Luke 8:4–15 – The Word grows where hearts are surrendered
- Day 2: Luke 8:22–25 – Jesus calms the storm (peace through surrender)
- Day 3: Luke 9:23–27 – Take up your cross daily
- Day 4: Luke 9:57–62 – The cost of following Jesus
- Day 5: Luke 10:1–20 – The harvest is plentiful, but surrender is required
- Day 6: Luke 10:21–24 – The joy of submission to God
- Day 7: Reflection: What areas of your life need surrender for God's power to flow?

**Key Prophetic Insight:** The glory of God is revealed in your surrender. When you let go of control, the Holy Spirit has room to work mightily through you.

**Prayer Focus:** Pray for a heart fully surrendered to God, trusting Him with every detail of your life.



## Week 6: Victory is the Kingdom's Song

Agenda: \*No more than 1hr, 15 min

- Music, Quiet Reflection (5-10 min before)
- Icebreaker/check-in/Kick it (5 minutes)
- Opening prayer (5 minutes)
- Scripture reading (10 minutes)
- Discussion questions (20-30 minutes)
- Prophetic insight sharing (10 minutes)
- Closing prayer and call to action (5 minutes)

**Theme:** The Power of Resurrection Overview: The journey to the cross reveals Jesus' ultimate victory, teaching us that surrender and sacrifice lead to triumph.

### Daily Readings:

- Day 1: Luke 19:28-40 – The triumphant entry into Jerusalem
- Day 2: Luke 22:39-46 – Jesus prays in the garden
- Day 3: Luke 23:26-43 – Jesus on the cross (victory through sacrifice)
- Day 4: Luke 23:44-49 – The veil is torn, and access to God is granted
- Day 5: Luke 24:1-12 – The resurrection changes everything
- Day 6: Luke 24:36-49 – Jesus gives the Spirit-filled commission
- Day 7: Reflection: How does the resurrection power of Jesus change your perspective on your battles?

**Key Prophetic Insight:** The resurrection declares that death, loss, and defeat do not have the final word. Through Jesus, you are already victorious.

**Prayer Focus:** Pray for resurrection power to flow through your life, reviving every dead place and calling you into new levels of victory.
