10 Practical Steps on How to Deliver When Your Water Breaks

1. Recognize the Moment

- Acknowledge that the breaking is the beginning of the work, not the end.
- Declare: "This is my time to deliver!"

2. Stay Focused on the Assignment

- Eliminate distractions and focus on what God has called you to do.
- Remind yourself: "I'm not looking to the left or the right—I'm focused on delivering!"

3. Surround Yourself with Support

- Call on your tribe—intercessors, mentors, and friends—to help you carry the weight of your assignment.
- Declare: "God has sent help to walk with me!"

4. Push Past the Pain

- Embrace the discomfort as part of the process of birthing something extraordinary.
- Declare: "The pain is producing my promise!"

5. Activate Your Faith Through Work

- Take action on what God has placed in your heart (write the vision, make the call, launch the ministry, etc.).
- Declare: "I will work to deliver what God has placed in me!"

6. Trust God's Timing

- Be patient and trust in God's perfect timing for the process to unfold.
- Declare: "God's timing is perfect, and I will trust Him!"

7. Prepare to Manage the Promise

• Be a good steward of what you've delivered. Seek wisdom and take intentional steps to protect and nurture it.



8. Don't Let Fear Stop You

- Step out boldly, even if fear tries to creep in, knowing God is with you.
- Declare: "I will not fear—I will deliver!"

9. Praise Through the Process

- Worship and thank God throughout the journey, even during the messy moments.
- Declare: "Lord, I praise You for what's being birthed through me!"

10. Proclaim the Victory

- Speak life over yourself and the promise God is bringing forth.
- Declare:
 - o "I am delivering with power!"
 - "What God placed in me will bless the nations!"
 - o "No weapon formed against my purpose will prosper!"
